Re: Clarification - Bahrain National Day Celebration at Capital School

To finish the term in an exciting and memorable way for all pupils, the team has been planning a National Day celebration on Thursday, 11 December. This will be a wonderful opportunity for pupils to come together in pride, unity, and cultural appreciation as we mark this significant occasion in the Bahrain national calendar.

To attend, children are kindly asked to contribute **BD 3**, which will grant access to the following activities:

- Traditional Games
- Henna Art
- Pottery Painting
- Falcon Tent
- Live Cooking and Hospitality Experiences
- Magic Show
- Face Painting
- Art Corner / Art Wall
- Live Traditional Band (Liwa)

In addition to the activity stations, there will be seven food stations offering a selection of items for purchase, along with eight home businesses selling customised merchandise such as mugs, necklaces, bracelets, toys, wallets, clothing, colouring books, and more. If you would like your child to purchase food or items from the home business stalls, please ensure they bring cash on the day.

As part of the celebrations, pupils in Years 9–12 will also take part in a special Football Tournament during the day. The event is designed to encourage teamwork, sportsmanship, positive competition, and unity, while reflecting key values of Bahrain such as respect, cooperation, loyalty, and community pride.

Pupils participating are asked to bring their football kit to school and may wear National Dress over their kit.

Once payment has been received, your child will be issued a wristband, which is required to access the activities listed above.

Pupils who will not be taking part in the outdoor National Day activities will still enjoy the occasion. They will join the festivities in the Multi-Purpose Hall and take part in engaging activities. Every pupil will have the opportunity to celebrate this special day together.


Parents are warmly invited to join their children and take part in the festivities according to the following schedule:
