Re: Upcoming Maths and Reading Intervention Sessions

At Capital School Bahrain, we are committed to providing every pupil with the support they need to make strong progress. To help achieve this, we will be running a series of intervention sessions for Maths and Reading starting next week.

These interventions will take place during the teaching of foundation subjects such as History, Geography, Music, Spanish (Key Stage 2 only), and Computing.
