Dear Parents and Guardians,

Re: Accessing Maths and Science Assessment Scores via Parent Portal for Y1-Y6

We are pleased to inform you that from **Sunday**, **12**th **October**, any completed Maths and Science unit assessment scores will be available to view via the **Parent Portal on iSAMS** (please see below for instructions on how to access these). In some year groups, you may only see the first unit marks for both subjects, as we are still at an early stage in the academic year.

Each unit includes two assessments and as a result, two scores:

- Initial Assessment: Taken before teaching begins to measure prior knowledge, so scores are expected to be low.
- End-of-Unit Assessment: Completed **after** the unit has been taught; you should see progress here.

As we move through the year, any completed Maths and Science unit assessments will be uploaded to the Parent Portal as soon as they are marked. Please note that release dates will vary across year groups, as unit lengths differ. We encourage you to check the portal regularly to stay up to date with your child's progress in these subjects.

In most cases, these two assessment scores will show the fantastic progress your child is making in these areas of the curriculum. In the rare instance that your child's **end-of-unit score** is lower than their **initial score**, please don't be alarmed — the class teacher will review this with your child and provide any necessary support.

In Maths, if a child scores below 70% in the end of unit assessment, they will join a small intervention group. These sessions will focus on revisiting and strengthening the key learning points from the unit and will begin next week. Following the intervention sessions, children will retake the same end of unit assessment to measure their progress.

We believe this process will help us provide targeted support and ensure every child has the opportunity to secure their understanding before moving on.


