Dear Parents and Guardians of Year 11 Pupils,

Re: Final Preparations for the IGCSE Mathematics Module 1 Examination – Year 11

As we approach the first module of the IGCSE Mathematics examination, which takes place at **11:30 a.m. on Wednesday, 5th November**, I would like to share our plans for the final few days leading up to this important assessment.

Our Year 11 teachers have been working hard to prepare pupils thoroughly, and we are very pleased with the progress shown in their recent mock examinations. The improvement since the summer is a real credit to the pupils' focus and commitment.

To date, pupils have completed all previous past exam papers, either in lessons or under controlled mock exam conditions. For any pupils wishing to undertake additional practice at home, all past papers and mark schemes can be accessed using the following link:

To further support pupils in these final days, we have put several additional activities in place:

- Walking-Talking Mock: During Periods 5 and 6 on Sunday and Monday Periods 3 & 4, teachers will guide pupils through a full exam paper, discussing strategies and common pitfalls while helping them identify any final areas for improvement.
- **Final Morning Revision:** On the **morning of the exam**, pupils will be **off-timetable** to take part in focused revision sessions with their teachers. These sessions will provide valuable last-minute support before pupils have a short break and enter the exam space.

Extra Help Sessions: Maths teachers will be **available every lunchtime** and for **30 minutes after school** from now until the exam for any pupils who wish to ask questions or seek clarification on particular topics.











Online Revision – Dr Frost: All pupils have been set targeted revision tasks on Dr Frost Maths, covering the full range of topics needed for Module 1. This is a self-marking resource that pupils can complete independently at home. If pupils experience any login issues, they should speak directly with their Maths teacher.
