Subject: Year 11 Autumn Term Reports and Mock Exam Results

We are pleased to inform you that the Autumn Term Reports for Year 11 are now available to view on the iSAMS Parent Portal. These reports provide an overview of your child's progress, effort, behaviour, and attainment across the curriculum studied this term.

Please note the following important details:

- The **grades shown in this report** are both the pupils '**working at**' and '**target grades**'. These are based on the recent mock examinations completed in December and are an indication of current performance and should be used to guide revision and preparation for the final exams. For non- iGCSE subjects (e.g., Social Studies, Citizenship, Islamic Studies, and PE), teachers are only indicating whether they're working above or below their class expectations.
- The **Mathematics grade included reflects the Term 1 assessment**.
- A reminder that the **official Pearson Edexcel grades for the Mathematics Unit 1 will be released on Thursday, 22nd January**. These externally assessed results will be shared with you as soon as they are available.
