Dear Parents,

RE: End of Week Update – Welcome Back & Online Learning Structure

I hope you and your families have had a restful Spring Break.

It has been truly wonderful to welcome our pupils back this week. Even in an online setting, it has been fantastic to see their enthusiasm, hear their voices again, and watch them reconnect with their teachers and classmates. The positivity and resilience shown by our children continues to be something we are incredibly proud of.

As we move into next week, our daily structure will remain largely the same, with a small but important addition to further support pupils' wellbeing and sense of connection.

From Sunday 29th March, pupils will be able to join their morning session from 8:45am. The first 15 minutes (8:45–9:00) will be dedicated time for children to:

- Talk with one another
- Check in with their teacher
- Reconnect socially before lessons begin

We feel this is a really important part of the day, helping to maintain a sense of normality and community.

From 9:00am to 12:30pm, teachers will continue to deliver:

- Daily Reading, Writing and Maths lessons
- Science and Humanities lessons across the week

In the afternoons:

Arabic lessons will continue daily from **12:45 PM to 1:20 PM**, during which both **Arabic A and Arabic B** will be taught.

Arabic B will be delivered in two groups according to the following schedule:

- **Group 1:** 12:45 PM – 1:20 PM
- **Group 2:** 1:30 PM – 2:00 PM
- **Days:** Sunday, Tuesday, and Thursday

A **weekly session** will also be conducted for all grade levels in the following subjects:

- Islamic Studies, Citizenship and Social Studies. Recorded lessons and assigned tasks will be provided throughout the week.

Kindly follow the links shared by the subject teacher to access the sessions and materials.

The final session from 1:45–2:30pm will be managed independently by parents, with pupils able to access the pre-recorded lessons and supporting materials prepared by our teachers. There is a choice of the following subjects for your child to complete

- PE
- Computing
- Art

We are currently reviewing this provision to ensure it remains the most effective approach for our pupils, and will keep you updated with any future changes.

Alongside this, we are working on streamlining how pupils access learning materials and how work is submitted. We recognise that clarity and simplicity are key, particularly in an online setting, and we want to ensure our systems are as user-friendly as possible for both pupils and parents. We will be sharing further details with you shortly on what this will look like moving forward. Our aim is to ensure that our online offer works effectively for all Capital families.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support. We know that learning online brings its own challenges, and we greatly appreciate the role you play in supporting your child's engagement each day. It has been a really positive start back, and we look forward to building on this in the week ahead.
