Dear Parents and Guardians of Year 10,

RE: Follow-up Update: Year 10 Maths & Science Modular Exams

We hope you are well. Following our recent communication regarding the postponement of the Year 10 Maths and Science modular examinations, we would like to share some further important updates.

We have now received official confirmation from Pearson that all student entries for the June 2026 modular examinations have been formally postponed to the November 2026 examination session. This applies to all Year 10 pupils, and any fees already paid will automatically be carried forward.

We would also like to reassure you that:

- Pupils will have the opportunity to sit their modular exams in November 2026, as part of the adjusted examination timeline.
- There will also be an opportunity for pupils to retake modules again in June 2027, providing flexibility as they move into Year 11.

It is important to remember that the period leading up to any examination is a critical time for pupils. Regular revision, mock examinations, and targeted feedback are essential components in ensuring they achieve their best possible grades. At present, due to the current circumstances, it is not possible to provide these key elements to the standard our pupils deserve. This has been a central factor in our decision-making.


Additionally, if the conflict comes to a swift conclusion and we find ourselves safely back in school with live, in-person lessons, we will work closely with the exam board to review this decision. Our priority is to ensure fairness, wellbeing, and the strongest learning conditions for all pupils.

Teaching of the scheme of work will continue into the new academic year, and pupils will receive appropriate revision time in preparation for the November examination session.
