RE: EYFS and Year 1 Update

Thank you for taking the time to complete the recent form and for your continued support during this period. Your responses have been invaluable in allowing us to plan carefully and ensure a safe and well-structured return for our youngest pupils.

We are pleased to confirm that class lists are now finalised, and our emergency procedures, registers, and operational plans have all been securely established. We are very much looking forward to welcoming those children who will be returning to school.

If you have not yet completed the form, we kindly ask that you do not bring your child into school at this stage. All ratios, procedures, and plans have been carefully organised based on the responses received. **Should you wish to change your decision** or submit a late response, please note that you will need to wait for confirmation from the school before your child can attend. This may take up to 48 hours from the time we receive your message, as we make the necessary internal adjustments to accommodate this safely. [The form can be found here.](#)

As previously outlined, pupils will be taught by familiar members of staff to ensure comfort and continuity; however, this may not always be their usual class teacher. Our priority is to ensure that all children are supported by adults they know and trust, within a safe and well-organised structure.

Upon arrival, all pupils are to use the same entrance as normal.

For pupils in FS1, all pupils are to go to Ms Sian's class in the FS1 corridor, and in FS2, they will go to their normal classrooms upon arrival.

Year 1 will be as follows:

- Deer and Fox pupils need to go to Deer Class.
- Squirrel, Rabbit and Hedgehog pupils go to Squirrel class.

For those children continuing with online learning, if their class teacher is delivering in-person lessons, you will receive a link via ClassDojo to join another class's live online sessions. This will ensure that all pupils continue to access high-quality teaching and remain fully engaged in their learning.

Thank you once again for your cooperation and understanding. We look forward to continuing to work closely with you and supporting all of our children, both in school and online.



Onsite Logistical Arrangement

Please be aware that local building works near the school site are currently causing some disruption to the smooth drop-off and collection arrangements. For the coming weeks, parents must use the first road from the Highway, which will temporarily function as a two-way entrance, bringing vehicles in through what is normally the school's "out" exit. Please exercise caution and drive safely while on site to help us keep everyone protected.

We also want to reassure all parents about the safety arrangements we have put in place to ensure that children are well looked after throughout the school day.
