**Dear Parents and Guardians,**

**RE: Secondary School Full Reopening**

Over the past week we have been welcoming Year 10, 11 and 12 pupils back into school as part of a carefully managed phased return to on-site learning.

Beginning with this year groups allowed us to ensure that staffing, timetabling and daily routines were working smoothly as more members of our school community returned to Bahrain. As the week has progressed, we have seen increasing numbers of staff and pupils able to attend school, and this has allowed us to steadily build our capacity on campus.

Following a review of staffing and operational arrangements, I am pleased to confirm that the Secondary school will move to full reopening from Sunday 26<sup>th</sup> April, with all year groups returning to campus.

The majority of our teaching staff will be in the school building and delivering lessons as usual. A small number of teachers are currently still outside Bahrain and will continue to teach their lessons live online. Where this occurs, pupils will remain in their classrooms with support staff present to assist with supervision and lesson organisation so that learning continues smoothly.

The school day for next week will run from 8:00 to 14:00, in line with the arrangements in place this week for Years 10, 11 and 12. It will follow a slightly modified timetable, similar to the structure pupils have been accustomed to during online learning. This approach will help maintain continuity and consistency as we transition back to full in-school provision.

Thank you for the patience and support our community has shown during this period. We look forward to welcoming all Secondary pupils back to campus and returning to a full school community together.
