**Re: Secondary School Update: Timetable Changes, Online Learning & Assessment Dates**  
**End of Day Timings**

I am writing to share an update regarding the Secondary School timetable. From next week, starting Monday 4<sup>th</sup> May, we will revert to our normal start and end-of-day timings across the school.

A reminder of our usual timings:

- Pupils should arrive no later than 07:45, when registration begins.
- Period 1 starts at 08:00.
- Sunday, Monday, Wednesday and Thursday: end of day at 14:50.
- Tuesday: end of day at 12:25.

**Online Learning**

With over 92% of our pupils now back in school, our priority is to ensure that classroom teaching remains of the highest quality. By focusing our resources in this way, we can maintain a consistent and high standard of education for all pupils.

Pupils who remain at home can continue to access learning materials via Microsoft Teams and online platforms such as Seneca Learning, Dr Frost Maths and SAM Learning. However, please note that no live lessons will be scheduled.

**Assessment Dates** (Years 7-10 only)

We will shortly share a full calendar outlining end-of-year events and key dates. As part of this, the assessment week will run from Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> June, with the possibility of additional assessments scheduled in the first few days of the week beginning 14<sup>th</sup> June, if required. Further details, including finalised student timetables, will be shared in due course.

On these days, pupils will attend school to complete their assessments and will return home once they have finished. This approach allows staff the necessary time to mark, assess and complete end-of-year reports to a high standard ahead of the end of the academic year.

For families currently outside of Bahrain, we will contact you directly to outline how end-of-year assessments will be managed and to ensure that appropriate arrangements are in place.
