Re: Access to Curriculum Plans and Teams for Secondary School

You can access them through Microsoft Classroom via <u>office.com</u>, using your child's login details. Their school email address and unique password will be required to log in. In addition, by the end of this week, we will also publish all of these plans on our school website under the *Curriculum* section, making them even easier to access.

Within each subject team area (as shown in the example image below), you will find a range of helpful materials and resources, including:

- Notices Channel for key updates, including upcoming assessment dates


