Secondary Lockers

We're also pleased to let you know that lockers are available for all our Secondary pupils to use during the school day. Having a personal locker is a great way for pupils to keep their belongings safe and organised while moving between lessons.

Each locker remains the property of the school, and we ask pupils to take care of it and keep it neat and tidy throughout the year. As part of our safeguarding and wellbeing responsibilities, lockers may occasionally be checked by the Head of Secondary or the Principal if there is reasonable concern about the contents. These checks, though rare, are always carried out with the utmost care and respect for our pupils.



Locker Deposit

A non-refundable deposit of **BD 5** is required for locker use.

Damage and Repairs

If a locker is accidentally damaged, we ask that it be reported straight away to the school counsellors so we can arrange a repair. Pupils may be asked to contribute to repair where appropriate.

Using the Lockers

To help with smooth movement around school, pupils may access their lockers **before school, during breaks, and after school**. Please note that lockers should be emptied before each school holiday, and food or perishable items should not be stored inside.

We appreciate your support in helping our pupils develop good organisational habits and responsibility for their personal space.

Our excellent school counsellors, Ms Yas and Ms Jehad, will coordinate the allocation of lockers and distribution of keys starting from Sunday 12th October. In order to facilitate a quick and smooth transition from payment to usage, pupils should bring their BD5 directly to the counsellors and they will be able to distribute the keys immediately
